What is a webinar?

A webinar is a presentation offered virtually over the Internet and telephone. Many organizations use webinars as a way to provide access to information to a large number of participants and/or an audience that is spread across many a large area.

How do I register?

Select the date you want to attend. Click on the link under the date you have selected below to register for one session. There is no cost for participating. You will automatically receive an email sent to the email address you used to register for the webinar about how to access the online presentation materials and what number to call on the day of the webinar.

Tips

Three steps are required to see AND listen to the presentation.

Step 1: Log in to the webinar 10 - 15 minutes before the scheduled time

Step 2: Call the telephone number provided to hear the presenters.

Step 3: Place your phone on mute (hit *6 or the mute button) so other participants can not hear background noise and can clearly hear the presenters.

Groups are welcome to gather around one phone (dial in, select the speaker option then mute the phone) to accommodate more participants.
